

Legion Riders Awards





South Brevard Stand Down

South Brevard Stand Down was a tremendous success. A total of 101 veterans received services from close to 200 volunteers. The services included the routine stand down care; i.e. medical care, legal advice, Service Officer referrals, showers, hot meals, hygiene, new clothes, haircuts and packages of food to go. What we had in addition was a tremendous hit. There were 15 female veterans from the Women's facility on Grissom Parkway who attended with their children and while the moms received the services and were pampered with manicures and pedicures, the children were well supervised in the Post play area. Several Service Dogs received grooming treatment from our resident dog groomer. Many veterans received dental exams and it is estimated that 13 will actually receive teeth!!! That's right, full and partial dentures. Many received cell phones for the first time from the on site vendor and ten yes that's right ten veterans were referred into housing!!! A new record!!!!

The community of Brevard really stepped up with in kind and monetary donations due to the media blitz in the days prior: Florida Today, Hometown News ran articles the day before, Radio Station 98.5 "The Beach" aired it hourly and Channel 13 ran a segment on it hourly for days before the stand down. It was pretty incredible. We even had veterans come from Orange and Indian River Counties. On-site the day of stand down, Mary Kemper from Veteran's Voice was there to interview several of our veterans and take pictures, there's a great article in the June 12th edition.

Despite the rain - the day was phenomenal - yes there were some glitches - and we intend to iron them out before the next one - yes we will be making this an annual event. So stay tuned.

I can't say enough about the wonderful volunteers who pulled together to make this happen - without them our guys and gals wouldn't have left smiling and happy the way they did!! Special thanks to our Commander Duane Podhola and the amazing Team Leads - leadership at its finest!!!!!
